

2025 MIE Summer Research Award

Value: \$6000 plus a minimum 25% supplement (\$1,500)

Eligibility of Students

- Requirements: MIE undergraduate students (international or domestic) working with MIE professors (this award is only open to MIE undergraduate students). Track one students who plan to transfer to MIE may apply but preference will be given to current MIE students.
- 2. Minimum Academic Requirement: Cumulative average of at least B- (2.7/70-72)
- 3. Registration Requirements:
 - **a.** Registered as a full-time or part-time student. Students who have withdrawn from the Faculty (for example, on a gap year) are not eligible.
 - **b.** In first, second, third, or fourth-year
- **4. Duration Requirement:** Available to work full-time for 4 months (16 full consecutive weeks). MIE administers this program in the summer term only, between May 1 and September 1 of each year.

Application Procedure

- 1. Complete the Student Application Form.
- **2.** Have your Proposed Supervised complete the Supervisor Form (Proposed Supervisor and Research Project).
- 3. Download your Unofficial ACORN Academic History (with your name visible).
- **4.** Combine the Student and Supervisor forms and your Unofficial ACORN Academic History into the application package as a **single PDF** with the following naming convention: "LastName, FirstName MIE SRA.pdf" (file size under 10 MB only).
- 5. Email the completed application (as a single PDF) to the MIE Undergraduate Office (undergrad@mie.utoronto.ca) by Monday March 3, 2025, at 11:59pm (eastern time).

Domestic students should apply for NSERC USRA, and they will automatically be considered for the MIE Undergraduate Summer Research Award. International & first year students should complete the MIE Undergraduate Summer Research Award application form.

Application Deadline

The deadline for applications is March 3, 2025, at 11:59pm (eastern time).
